

Sickness procedures

If your child becomes ill during the school day, we will contact you to come and collect him/her. Please think carefully about whether your child is well enough to return to school. Ask for advice if you are not sure what to do.

- Children who have sickness and diarrhoea will need to be free of symptoms for 48 hours before they return to school.
- If your child needs to have medicine administered at school or uses an inhaler then a medical form will need to be completed before we can hold/administer the inhaler/medication in school.
- Other illnesses please ask for advice if you are unsure whether your child should be in school or not.
- Head lice are not a serious health problem and rarely cause anything more than an itchy scalp. Head lice are not associated with poor hygiene; they are not selective and do not have a preference for clean or dirty hair. Good checking and care of hair by parents/carers is the best way to control head lice so please be vigilant and let us know if your child has an infestation and treat their hair accordingly. If head lice is identified on the child while they are in school their parent will be notified. Long hair must always be tied back.
