Animals - including humans

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amounts of nutrition; that they cannot make their own food and they get nutrition from what they eat. Identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

- 1. Explain how living things obtain food
- 2. Identify different food groups
- 3. Compare and group animals according to their diet
- 4. Sort animals based on their skeletons
- 5. Identify the main bones in the human body and the 3 functions of the skeleton
- 6. Explain why we need muscles to move
