Reading – at least three times per week, signed



- Timestables Go on TT Rockstars. Aim to go on at least twice a week. Try to make sure that at least one session is on Studio.

#### Welcome to Aslan Base!

Our class is named after Aslan, a talking lion in the classic book 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'. The book was written by C. S. Lewis and is part of a series 'The Chronicles of Namia'. He is the only character to appear in all seven books of the series.



#### The Curriculum and Assessments

- English: There is a big push on spelling and grammar in the English curriculum.
- The children are assessed against age related targets. They will be assessed as either below expected standard, working towards expected standard, at expected standard and working at a greater depth within expected standard.

Maths Times Tables: These continue to be essential for all elements of the maths curriculum. It is expected that all children know all their times tables (up to 12 x 12) by the end of Year 4. An online test (the Muliplication Tables Check or MTC) is used in July.



#### Times Tables – TT Rockstars

Use TT Rockstars, especially Jamming, Garage and Soundcheck to help speed up recall.

The Soundcheck game is modelled on the Multiplication Tables Check where children have 6 seconds to answer a question. There are 25 randomly selected questions.





## Spelling and Spelling Shed

Similarly, spelling is an essential element of the English curriculum.

Each week children will have a spelling test in class. Children will have ten words (though some children may have less) based on a spelling theme or pattern.

Use Spelling Shed to help learn the spellings at home.
