














Multiplication Game

You will need two counters, two pencils and two pieces of paper.

- Play the game with a partner.
- Place both counters on the rocket.
- Take turns to move your counter one square at a time in any direction except diagonally.
- For each number you land on, write a multiplication that has this as the answer. You cannot use the number 1, or repeat a multiplication that has already been written.
- If a player writes an incorrect multiplication, they must move back to their previous square!
- Who gets to the moon first?
- Play the game a few times, taking turns to start first.
