Write a short piece of writing (about half a page) of direct speech using your family members as the characters. The writing could show a real life scene or be imaginary. Remember to punctuate the direct speech, e.g.: use inverted commas; add a comma, full stop, exclamation or question mark inside the inverted commas; and start a new line for a new speaker.
