Level 3 Bikeability Course

Bikeability is the Department for Transport's national award provider for cycle training in England. It is designed to give the next generation of children the skills and confidence to ride their bikes on today's roads.

There are three Bikeability levels. If your child has completed Bikeability level 1 and 2 in Primary School and is confident cycling on quiet roads, then the next step is Level 3.

Level 3 training takes on more challenging roads and traffic situations. This will consist of roundabouts, traffic lights, cycle lanes and busier roads and junctions generally. Level 3 also looks at planning a safe riding route to school, or local shops and friends. The course takes 2 hours to complete and is currently funded by Dorset County Council.
