Dear Parents/Carers,

Wraparound Care Club at Blandford St Mary CE Primary School

We are delighted to inform you that we offer both a Breakfast Club and an After School Club, enabling us to provide a full wrap-around care package to our children and families.

Breakfast Club is from 7:45am until the school day begins at 8:30am and our After School Club is from 3.15pm until 5.45pm Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays and from 3:15pm to 5:15pm on Mondays and Fridays. The sessions and costs are laid out below. A light snack will be given at the start of Short After School Club (3.15 - 4.15pm), and a more substantial snack after 4:15pm.

Our session times and fees are as follows:

3:15pm – 5:45pm Full After School Club	£11.00	N/A
7:45am - 5:15pm (Monday and Friday) 7:45am – 5:45pm (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday)	£11.50 £14:00	See above

We are aware some of our children may attend an after school club and will need childcare from 4:15pm. In this instance, the costs are as follows:

4:15pm – 5:15pm Middle session	£4.50	Light bite provided by club such as beans on toast etc. (This will not be a substitute for the child's dinner when they get home).
4:15pm – 5:45pm Full After School Club	£7.00	N/A PLEASE NOTE THIS SESSION <b>IF</b> COMBINED WITH BREAKFAST CAN ONLY BE BOOKED BY THE OFFICE STAFF – please let them know in advance if you wish to choose this option.

Children eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant will receive 50% discount on fees.

A quiet area will be available for the children to complete their homework/reading and iPads will be supplied for children to access TT Rockstars, Spellings Shed, Numbots and other educational games. Children will also have access to arts and crafts, loom band making kits, board games, and in suitable weather conditions, will be able to play outside. The children may also appreciate having a little down time after a busy day at school and therefore mats and bean bags will be set out for the children so that they can watch 'The Big Screen' in comfort.

As as we are now providing an After School Club, children who are not picked by 3:20pm will be taken to the After School Club and parents/carers charged accordingly.

Should you wish to avail of this childcare, please read the attached After School Club Policy and complete and return the registration form.
